CAROLYN SLIGHTOM, YOUR IASCOE VICE PRESIDENT

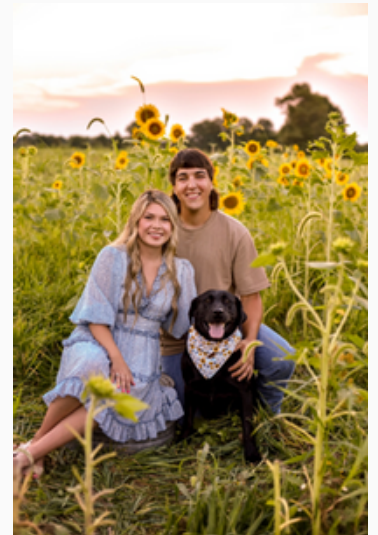
